I am extremely happy to share with you the following interesting data in respect of performance of JNV students in JEE Main and Advanced examination:-

01.	No. of JNV candidates registered for JEE(Main) 2017	9757
02.	No. of JNV candidates eligible from JEE (Main)	3563
03.	No. of JNV candidates appeared JEE (Advanced) 2017	2747
04.	No. of JNV candidates qualified in JEE (Advanced)	1176
05.	No. of JNV candidates appeared & qualified in NEET-2017	14183 & 11875

The result in first stage and second stage is 36.52% and 42.81% respectively. I do not think any group of schools have such a huge potentiality. Entire credit of grooming the children goes to the teachers, Principals and the officers who have toiled their energy. Out of these around 400 successful students were trained specifically through Centres of excellence. Remaining have come up naturally through the support in the Vidyalayas.

I take this opportunity to express my heartfelt Congratulations to you for putting in your sincere efforts which helped our Navodaya students to produce an excellent result in JEE (Advanced) nearing 43%. This is indeed a big achievement for the entire Navodaya family. Systematic order or activities, active participation of the children, congenial relations amongst the individuals in the Vidyalaya and professional teaching methodologies give great results. Conduct of many co-curricular activities enhances the learning environment. We wish that proactive approach and positive reinforcement should inculcate the winning attitude in the young minds. I deeply appreciate their efforts and commitment in this direction.

Complacency is the greatest hurdle one has to cross in the system. In my assessment the performance of the Navodaya children could be much bigger if little more efforts are made at the ground level in terms of providing stronger teaching methodologies in the lower classes. Clearing concepts and concretising the conceptual understanding has to begin much earlier in the schools. Hence the role of TGTs and the guidance of PGTs in the lower classes is much more important.

I have been continuously discussing this issue with the Principals and teachers during my meeting with them. We would welcome any idea which can be practically implemented at our own level to enhance the performances of the children.
